Variation of condition 2 (list of plans) attached to planning permission P23/03013/HH to amend the rear elevation of the extension to 'rendered' as opposed to the approved reconstituted coursed stone, and to alter the side cheeks of the rear elevation to buff faced block. Alter plinth to the front porch to brick rather than the approved reconstituted coursed stone - Demolition of existing Conservatory. Erection of single storey rear extension to provide additional living accommodation. Erection of replacement porch. P24/01470/RVC
