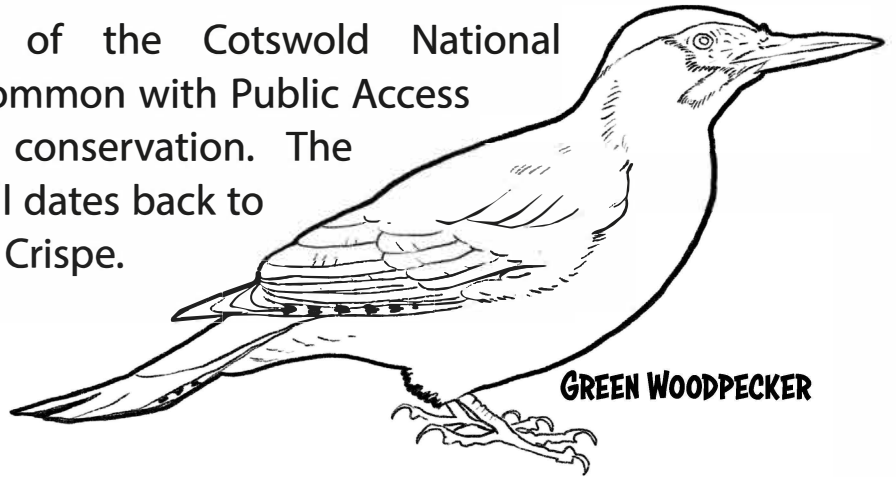
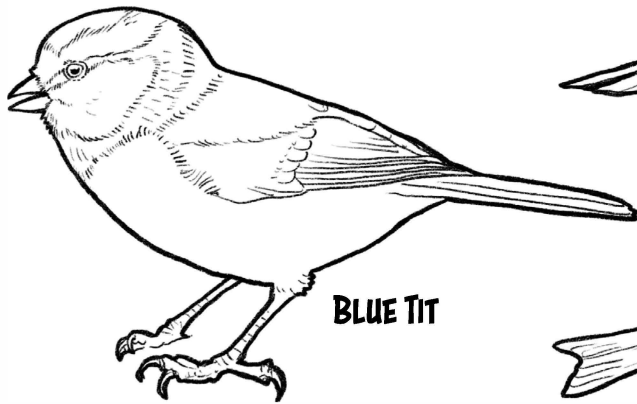


# RINGSWELL COMMON

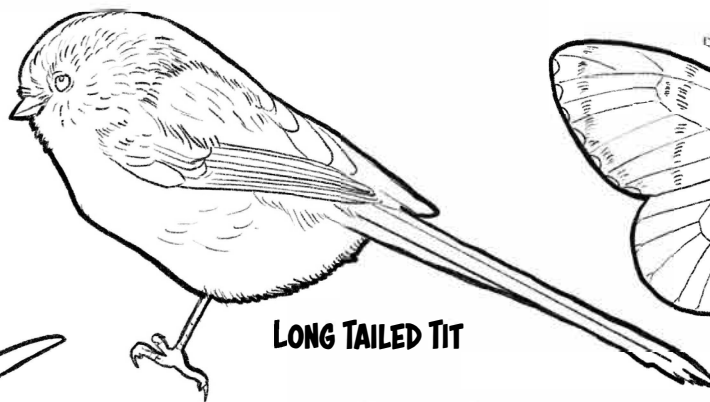

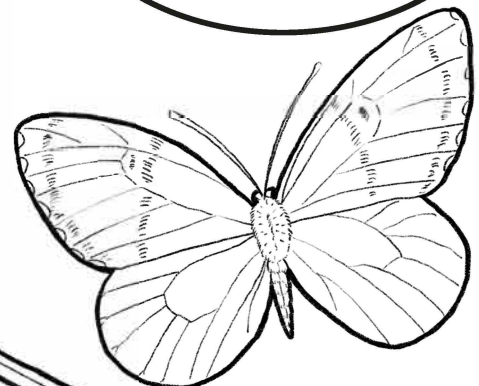
