- a) Highway Matters – The disabled parking place in the High Street has now been remarked following the resurfacing. However due to cars parking in the way yellow lines that need reinstating at the junction of Touching End Lane have yet to be done. Because of the inconsiderate parking on yellow lines we should ask enforcement to come to the village and look at dangerous parking. It is felt that the corners and opposite the Nelson are bad especially at weekends and evenings.
